he 55th Annual Meeting of the Kentucky Forest Industries Association, (KFIA), will be held at The Brown Hotel in Louisville, Kentucky on

August 25, 26 & 27, 2020. The theme of the meeting will be **Growing Kentucky Forests, Supplying the World**. The past year has brought a challenging economy and numerous changes related to export markets and concerns with log supply and changing legislation. We have some excellent speakers lined up to discuss the current issues related to export markets, hardwood cross laminated timber use, and the new Hardwood Promotion Collaboration. The meeting will feature a number of activities including a "Welcome Reception" for early arrivals and a golf outing on Tuesday. Wednesday and Thursday mornings will include speakers on topics of importance to the industry and an Exhibitor reception and Luncheon will provide plenty of opportunities to meet attendees.
